### Approved Training Organisations (ATO) | EASA

This Procedure Manual for Approved Training Organization has been developed by Civil Aviation Authority of Nepal (CAAN) to facilitate the CAAN officials to approve the Approved Training Organization (ATO) so that the intent of Personnel Licensing Requirement (PELR) is fulfilled and ultimately the requirement of ICAO Annex 1 is addressed in relation to the personnel licensing.

### APPROVED TRAINING ORGANISATION (ATO) PROCEDURES MANUAL ...

The training course approval is valid as long as: (a) the ATO has not been surrendered, superseded, limited, suspended or revoked; and (b) all operations are conducted in compliance with Part-ORA, Part-FCL, other applicable regulations, and, when relevant, with the procedures in the organisation's documentation as required by Part-ORA.

Approved training organisations (ATO) Initial certification of an ATO; Initial certification of an ATO. In accordance with Regulation (EC) No 216/2008 and Annex VII of Part ORA of Regulation (EU) No 1178/2011, each aircrew training organisation requires an ATO (Approved Training Organisation) certificate in order to provide training courses.

Though ideally ATO functions should relate to approved training for the issuance of Annex 1 licence or rating, however due to paucity of adequate training centers, ATOs will be allowed to undertake initial type training, recurrent and upgrade trainings also. COMPLEX ORGANISATIONS - COMPLIANCE MONITORING PROGRAMME FOR ATOs (a) Typical subject areas for compliance monitoring audits and inspections for approved training organisations (ATOs) should be the following: (1) facilities; (2) actual flight and ground training; (3) technical standards.

### Audit Considerations Related to Compliance Monitoring ...

Training towards the issue or renewal of European professional pilot's licences and the associated ratings must be provided by an 'Approved Training Organisation' (ATO). The approval has to be issued by one of the European Competent Authorities who will verify that the organisation complies with the requirements of the Aircrew regulation.

### cloud.gov - ATO process

A training organisation is considered an ATO or ATO-PEI when it is accredited by SSG to provide WSQ training & assessments, or WSQ training & assessments and PE courses. For existing ATOs who wish to apply for Enhanced Registration Framework (ERF) as a PEI, existing PEIs who wish to apply to become an ATO or new applicant wanting to apply to become an ATO-PEI, the following pre-requisites apply.

### Becoming a WSQ Approved Training Organisation (ATO) and ...

An applicant for an approved training organisation (ATO) certificate and training specifications, or for an amendment to an ATO certificate and training specifications, shall apply at least ninety days before the beginning of any proposed training which was not approved before.

### Requirements for ATOs - CITB

An Accredited Training Organisation (ATO) is an employer that has been certified by the Singapore Accountancy Commission (SAC) to possess the appropriate standards of staff training, accountancy resources and development for Singapore CA Qualification Candidates to fulfil their Practical Experience. Candidates will begin accumulating their 3-year Practical Experience required to qualify as a Chartered Accountant of Singapore immediately upon employment by an ATO.

If you are training to qualify for a pilot's licence, you must undergo training at either an approved training organisation (ATO) or registered training facility (RTF). Approved training organisations (ATOs) Names and details of all ATOs approved by the CAA are found in Standards Document 31.

List of approved training organisations (ATO) The CAA ensures continuous oversight of approved training organisations (flight schools) in the Republic of Slovenia. The oversight focuses on proper conduct of all approved training courses, implementation of learning objectives and training requirements, and adequacy of facilities and personnel.

This document defines the organisation and procedures upon which the EASA PART- ORA Training. approval is based. These procedures are approved by the undersigned and must be complied with, as applicable, whenever training is being delivered under the terms of the PART-ORA approval and other EASA.

### **1. APPROVED TRAINING ORGANISATION MANUAL**

An Approved Training Organisation (ATO) is required to comply with Part ORA of Regulation (EU) No 1178/2011 and either Part-NCC or Part-NCO of Regulation (EU) No 965/2012, depending on the aircraft being operated. Part-ORO is not applicable to ATOs.
