Unlike Afro-Cuban patterns which adheres to a fixed rhythmic pattern, Bossa Nova comping is more fluid and organic as it varies over time and doesn't adhere to a rigid formula. The only requirements is that the comping is syncopated – so use at least 1 or 2 off-beats.

A bossa nova phrase -motif- commonly goes for 8 bars. If it's a 4/4 song, it naturally goes for 4 bars. It means the motif repeats itself after 8 bars and the phrase goes along until the section ends. You would play bossa nova with a 2/4 time signature on your acoustic guitar instead of your electric guitar.

Bossa is about syncopated rhythms and a subtle ambiguity between 2 and 4 feel. Unlike in a Cuban clave, the patterns change. As in samba, notes can begin on a weak breat or weak part of a beat and tie over a bar line. No matter how lyrical the melody and smooth the delivery, samba is always just beneath the surface.

Bossa nova is at heart a guitar-based style when listening to the original recordings one cant help noticing how the melodies unfold over a cool background of nylon-string guitar chords, played in a relaxed but syncopated style. In the absence of a guitar, the piano often takes over this role, known as comping (short for accompanying).
