Chrysler Engine Casting Numbers

Casting numbers for the small-block Mopar and big-block Mopar engine blocks can be found on the left (driver's) side of the block, and will consist of seven numerals. These numbers are different than the stamped eight-digit number found on the right side of the engine. That number is the last eight digits of the Vehicle Identification Number.

Engine type is coded in Chrysler VINs beginning in 1966. Prior to 1966, the VIN only distinguished a 6 cylinder model from an 8 cylinder model. Chrysler used two VIN systems. The first, used from 1966-1980, has 13 digits, and the engine code is the 5th digit. The second has 17 digits and the engine code is the 8th digit. As usual, there's an exception.

Most of these blocks had a boss with room for both holes, but they were not always drilled. These engines all came with flat tappet cams. Look for casting number 4104230 or 4179730. 1985-'89 CAR AND 1985-'90 TRUCK Chrysler changed the block in '85 to accommodate roller lifters by adding three bosses in the lifter valley for the lifter holddowns.

Please note that while a casting number on an engine intake manifold, cylinder head or other part can identify a Chrysler 383 component, such identification is not the same thing as identifying the engine as a 383. Identify by Block Casting Number Step 1 Locate the large, seven-digit casting number stamped on left side of block.

In 1955, Chrysler started putting more information into their VINs, with 1 being the make (e.g. C = Chrysler), 2 and 3 being the year (e.g. 55 for 1955), and the remainder being a sequential build number. In 1958, Chrysler switched the year to the first letter (it was L), and the second two places were for the car model. Randy Knox wrote:

In a nutshell, matching numbers refers to the various casting numbers, codes and dates found on all the major driveline components (engine, transmission, rear-axle assembly). On later models, the engine block and transmission carry the V.I.N. number as well as the part number and i.d. codes. But it doesn't stop there.

Casting Numbers Casting numbers of the 318 are either on the driver or passenger side of the engine block. Chrysler was not always consistent with its location. Casting numbers include a foundry casting date, which simply reads, for example, 6.6.68 for June 6, 1968.
