Classical Conditioning Examples

- The diminishing of conditioned response; occurs in a classical conditioning when an unconditioned stimulus (US) does not follow a conditioned stimulus (CS); occurs in operant conditioning when a response is no longer reinforced. Ex: The less salivation to the tone after sounded without the present of food.
