**INITIAL CAVITY PREPARATION STAGE** - Definition : Initial cavity preparation is the extension and initial design of the external walls of the preparation at a specified, limited depth so as to provide access to the cavity or defect, reach sound tooth structure, resist fracture of the tooth or restorative material form masticatory forces principally directed with long axis of the tooth and retain the restorative material in the tooth.

### Some Fundamentals of Amalgam Cavity Preparation ...

The fundamental concepts relating to conventional and modified tooth preparation are the same: (1) all unsupported enamel tooth structure is normally removed; (2) the fault, defect, or caries is removed; (3) the remaining tooth structure is left as strong as possible; (4) the underlying pulpal tissue is protected; and (5) the restorative material is retained in a strong, esthetic (whenever possible), and functional manner.

Compound and complex cavities may include one or both of the proximal surfaces as well as portions of the facial and lingual surfaces. When caries attack the proximal surfaces of posterior teeth, the cavity preparation must also include preparation of the occlusal surfaces.

For an adhesively retained restoration, cavity preparation is usually limited to access to the defect, removal of diseased/compromised tissue (and/or failed restorative material) and development of a convenience form to facilitate matrix placement and application of the restorative material. All peripheral stain should also be removed to avoid poor aesthetics and to optimise adhesion.
