How can Jesus and the Bible both be the Word of God ...

This is John's meaning when he says that Jesus is the Word. He meant that Jesus is the physical manifestation of God the Father, just as a spoken word is the physical manifestation of our inner thoughts. Until Jesus took action and created the universe, there was no physical reality to God's presence.

Most Trinitarians believe that the word logos refers directly to Jesus Christ, so in most versions of John logos is capitalized and translated "Word" (some versions even write "Jesus Christ" in John 1:1).

Does John 1:1 prove that Jesus is God? An explanation of ...

The name "Jesus" is derived from the Hebrew-Aramaic word "Yeshua," meaning "Yahweh [the Lord] is salvation." The name "Christ" is actually a title for Jesus. It comes from the Greek word "Christos," meaning "the Anointed One," or "Messiah" in Hebrew. Jesus is the central figure in Christianity.

Profile of Jesus Christ, the Central Figure in Christianity

"The Word" is the subject because "Word" (Gr. logos) is preceded by the definite article "the." It is vital to ask and answer, first, why is God put forward in the sentence? Second, why does "God" lack the definite article? Before these questions are answered, however, a word must be said about two heretical doctrines known as Arianism and Sabellianism. The former states that Jesus was the first of God's creation.
