Kivalina has been at its current location since its school was built in the early 1900s. In 2000, the community settled on a nearby—and potentially safer—site for relocation, dubbed Kiniktuuraq. However, investigations by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers determined that Kiniktuuraq could also fall victim to climate change impacts over time.

In the fall of 1970, a storm with a 13.57-foot sea rise inundated the streets with seawater. Then another fall storm in September 1976, flooded 20 to 30% of the town. Despite the storms and the beach erosion, Kivalina continued to develop with new housing, a high school, and a new community-wide electrical system.
