A complete subject includes all the words in a sentence that name whom or what the sentence is about. A complete predicate tells what the subject does. It can also describe the subject. ### Sentence Fragments Answers - Lesson Worksheets

Sentence Fragments. Every sentence must contain three elements for it to be a complete sentence: a subject, a predicate, and, a complete thought. If a sentence is lacking in one or more of those areas, then the sentence is a fragment. A fragment is missing an important part of a sentence; therefore, it can't function properly. You may never know that it is a fragment.

### Sentence Fragments - McDougal Littell Pages 1 - 4 - Text ...

When you have a nice helping of words, but they just aren't quite a sentence this is called a sentence fragment. In order to qualify as a sentence the group of words has to have a subject and a verb this is called an independent clause. The sentence must also be solid by itself and not be missing pieces. When you read a sentence fragment you will catch yourself saying, "That just doesn't sound right!"

### Sentence Fragment Worksheets

Ask students to generate a definition for fragment. "A fragment is a piece of something." Teacher asks, "So if a fragment is a piece of something, what do you think a sentence fragment is?" "Yes, a sentence fragment is a piece of a sentence." Introduction to New Material: Have students recall the parts of a sentence.

### Unit 1: Subjects, Predicates, and Sentences

Review that, in order to be a complete sentence, a sentence needs a subject and a predicate. If a sentence doesn't have both, it's a fragment. A complete thought (or complete sentence) has a subject and a predicate. That means you can identify a "who/what" and a "what about it."
