Nonprofit Collaboration 2.0 (SSIR)

In a “supplementary model,” nonprofits fulfill a demand for public goods left unsatisfied by government. In a “complementary view,” nonprofits operate as partners with government, to deliver public goods. And in an “adversarial view,” nonprofits exist mainly to prod government into adjusting its policies to provide public goods.
