The only detailed treatment is in Father J. P. Crazzolaro's Zur Gesellschaft und Religion der Nueer (1953), much of which appeared earlier in volume viii of Father W. Schmidt's Der Ursprung der Gottesidee (1949).

The Nuer religion is animistic in many respects, but they also worship a creator named "Kowth." All life is believed to both come from and return to Kowth. The Nuer pray and offer sacrifices of cattle to Kowth, hoping for health and well-being, to ward off danger or evil, and as part of ceremonies such as marriage. There is no organized hierarchy of religious practitioners, although individuals may become diviners or healers.
