A care plan is developed for each of the patient's medical conditions being managed with pharmacotherapy. Care plans include goals of therapy, interventions, and a schedule for the next follow-up evaluation. A goal of therapy is the desired response or endpoint that you and your patient want to achieve from pharmacotherapy.

The pharmacist implements the care plan in collaboration with other health care professionals and the patient or caregiver. During the process of implementing the care plan, the pharmacist: Addresses medication- and health-related problems and engages in preventive care strategies, including vaccine administration.

Pharmaceutical care is understood as a quality concept and working method for the responsible provision of medicine therapy for definite outcomes in the interest of patients' quality of life (Hepler and Strand's definition - 1990).
