There are dozens of different back and spine surgeries that may be recommended by your orthopedic surgeon. Most of the time, back or spine surgery is only recommended after non-surgical, less invasive treatments like physical therapy, injections, or acupuncture have been tried and are no longer effective.

A variety of nonsurgical treatment alternatives exists for acute and chronic low back pain. Patients should receive appropriate education about the favorable natural history of low back pain, basic body mechanics, and methods (eg, exercises, activity modification, behavioral modification) that can reduce symptoms.

Nonsurgical Management of Acute and Chronic Low Back Pain

Patients usually present with low back pain, which may be associated with a radiating leg pain. Again, non-operative treatments can be used as first-line management, however surgical treatment with fusion can be used as an alternative when symptoms persist or become unbearable.
